

The editorial work on this book wasn't quite up to par. I found quite a few grammar and formatting errors that jumped off the page and should have been easily recognized (example: 11 says "makeup", 12 says "make up"). The author provided website information for getting free samples and such and it felt like a book of her sharing her affiliate link so she could make money off from her readers. I was shocked to see that she included her referral codes for certain websites. Many of her suggestions are common sense, yet some of her suggestions are to the extremeâ "actually states to not buy tampons and pads as well as reusing bath water for the entire family! And to suggest sneaking your own soda into a restaurant, asking your neighbors for food they do not want, and

suggesting dumpster diving is just absurd. You need not live like a hobo to save money...she really is suggesting a lot of very bad behavior. I received the Kindle version for free in exchange for my honest and unbiased review of which I have provided.

Most of these hints I knew. It would good for someone new to the frugal game, but caution needs to be taken when mentioning things such as "dumpster diving." In some places, it is illegal. Also, about napkins and straws, if they were sent along, that is fine, but you cannot just walk up to a table and take napkins and straws. It's called good manners. Frugal does not equal bad manners. I found a few grammatical errors, nothing huge, but it can detract if you are a very discerning reader. They did not really bother me, personally.
