
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# Fifty Ways To Teach Them Grammar: Tips For ESL/EFL Teachers

with little coherence in the way of order. The activities mentioned are a varied mix of TS and SS and many of the activities would only last 5 minutes or less in a regular class room. Due to the mixing pot order of the activities sometimes this book was a little difficult to navigate when searching for a specific grammar point. However for a beginner to ESL teaching the kindle version is totally worth the price.
