

The author gives great examples of what not to do and offers suggestions to further the process like contacting an attorney or asking a realtor for the Comps in your area.

This book was a good quick read for the basics of selling a home. A lot of it seemed like common sense (i.e. declutter and clean your home, price it lower if you want to sell quicker) but a few worthwhile tips. The book was not very in depth, and had very little about the specifics of the For Sale By Owner process vs going through an agent. For example, there was no mention of how to address buyers who may already be signed with an agent for which they'd be wanting you to pay buyer's agent commission. For \$.99 perhaps worth it as an overview on the topic. But to actually be prepared to sell my house FSBO I still feel I need a much more in depth primer on the pros/cons, and the details of how to do it.

This is a book that everyone should read even if you arenâ <sup>™</sup>t ready to put your house up for sale. I never stopped to think about the kind of improvements that would bring back money in the pocket if and when we decided to sell our home. All the scary parts of handling a FSBO are explained in a way that made me confident I could go through the process, succeed and not hand over a big chunk of money to a realtor.
