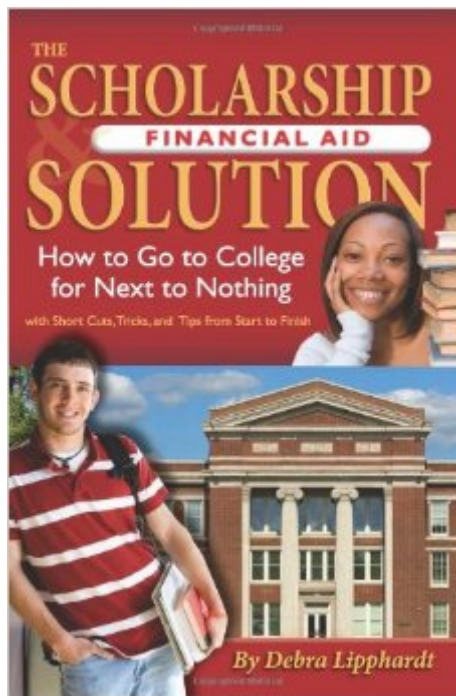

Where was this book when I was looking for help to finance college myself? I recall my guidance counselor handing me a single scholarship application, not the dozens (or hundreds) that today's student has available to them. Fortunately, I did receive that scholarship; I can attest, it's a great feeling to read the words, "You've been awarded..." As the "semi-retired" parents of a junior high school student, what we have learned from this book is that it's not too early to make use of this comprehensive guide to college scholarships and financial aid. It helps us to keep our "eyes on the prize" and gently steer our son in the right direction, in terms of his current academic studies, as well as his extra-curricular activities. Unless you get 1600 on your SATs, you're likely not going to get a scholarship without being a well-rounded individual, with more than just book smarts. Ms. Lipphardt addresses the process step-by-step, from helping you determine which scholarships you're eligible for (and it may be a single criterion that qualifies or disqualifies an applicant), filling out the application ("neatness counts!"), obtaining letters of recommendation or referral (who to ask, who not to ask, proofread well, and thank you notes afterward), and providing tips for the dreaded "essay" portion (know your audience, be truthful, etc). This book provided a thorough, simple, easy to understand discussion on the role of both the student and parent, and what it takes to get successfully navigate the scholarship labyrinth. From my reading, it's obvious that it's not an easy effort, but rather time consuming and tedious, to weed through the available scholarships, sort out the good from the bad, and the eligible to apply from the ineligible to apply.
